

The Royal Institute of Technology (KTH), Division of Transportation and Logistics, in Stockholm Sweden, is seeking applicants for a tenure-track position at the level of assistant professor, effective Fall 2010. The subject area is in Intelligent Transportation Systems, and application of information and communication technologies towards more efficient and sustainable transportation systems operations.
