Sustainable Mobility in the Metropolitan Region of Munich – Complexities, Challenges, Perspectives

Beginning **July 1st, 2011**, there will be eight doctoral scholarships to be awarded within the framework of the Hans Böckler Foundation and the **TU München's** mobil. TUM doctoral programme named as 'mobil. LAB'. The scholarships will be awarded for a maximum period of three years and will support the following research priorities concetually and empirically oriented to the metropolitan region of Munich:

- 1. regional spatial and transport systems
- 2. travel behaviour
- 3. regional mobility culture
- 4. governance processes.

Awarding of the above mentioned eight scholarships will be decided according to the guidelines of the BMBF and the selection and funding criteria of the Hans-Böckler-Stiftung. Applicants must demonstrate an above average final degree standing as well as voluntary commitment to trade unions and/or social organizations.
